We paired low-income, first-time parents in 159 families with caring nurse home visitors to improve their health and well-being.

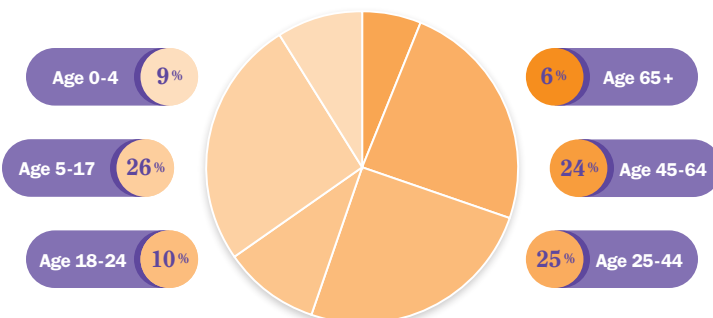


Caring Together
